

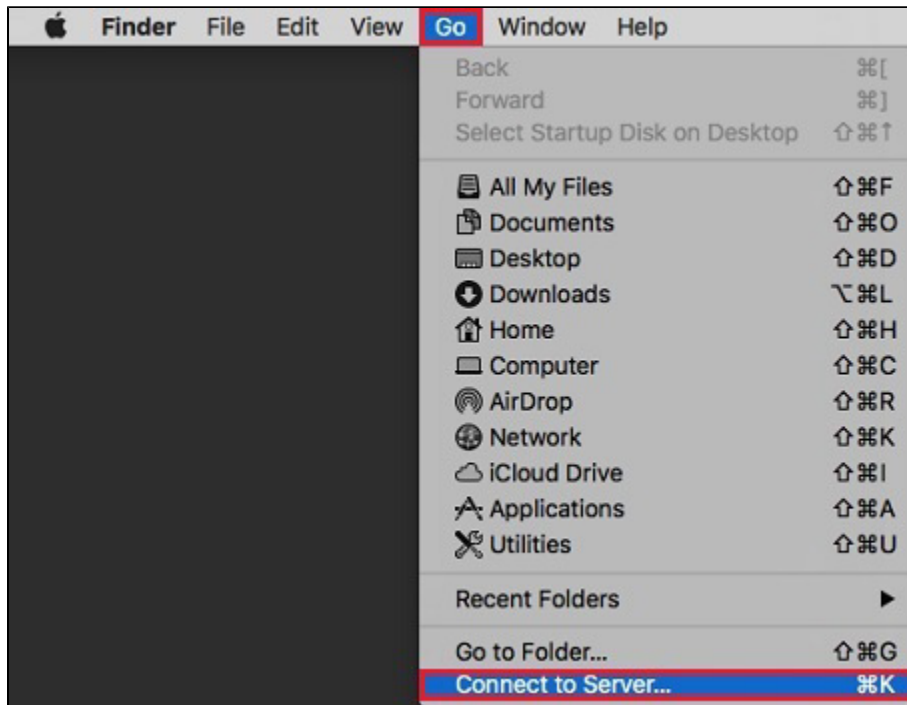
Connect to Network Drive on your Mac

1) Connect to the TTUnet. If you are off campus, you may connect to the TTUnet using a VPN connection.

TIP: For assistance with setting up a TTUnet VPN connection, please see How to: Download and install **GlobalProtect TTUnet VPN** on your Mac.

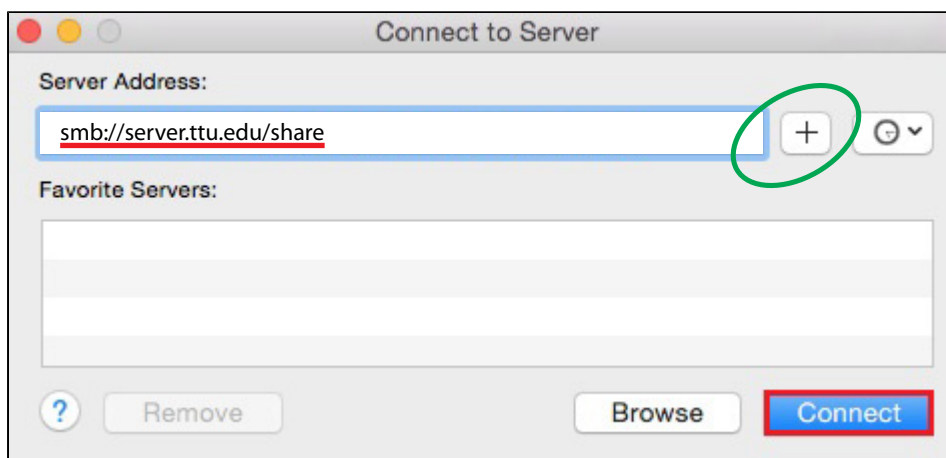
2) Click on an empty space anywhere on the desktop. This will make Finder the active program in the menu bar.

3) On the menu bar, click **Go**, and then **Connect to Server**.



4) type ***smb://server.ttu.edu/share***, where *share* is the name of your department's shared folder. Click **Connect**.

TIP: Before clicking "Connect", you may wish to click the plus symbol (+) to add the Drive Folder to your list of Favorites. This will make it easier to reconnect in the future.



5) If you are prompted to sign in, select **Registered User**, type in your eRaider credentials, and click **Connect**.

- **Name:** *your_eRaider_username*
- **Password:** *your_eRaider_password*
